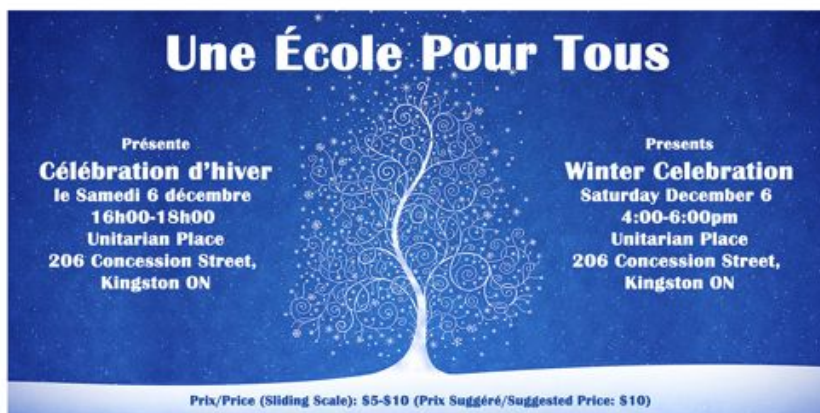
Unitarian Place: 206 Concession Street (please use the entrance at the back right hand side of the building, there is parking behind the building)
